


## Viewing RSS Feeds With Apple Safari

**Information for Counsel in September 11 Litigation**

Unless otherwise noted, all hearings and conferences will be held in Judge Hellerstein's courtroom, 14D, 500 Pearl Street.

Cases involving claims arising out of, resulting from, or relating to the terrorist-related aircraft crashes of September 11, 2001 and naming an airline, an airport security company, and/or The Port Authority of New York and New Jersey have been consolidated for discovery and other pre-trial proceedings. Honorable Alvin K. Hellerstein, District Judge, is presiding. Counsel in such cases should familiarize themselves with Judge Hellerstein's Rules of Practice and Rules for Sept. 11 Consolidated Cases, as well as his rulings relating to the September 11 Litigation.

**Filing of Correspondence**

There has been some confusion about how parties in all cases pending before Judge Hellerstein related to the September 11 Litigation should file documents with the Court.

- In the 21 MC 97 (personal injury and wrongful death); 21 MC 100 (respiratory injury); and 21 MC 101 (property damage) cases, ALL CORRESPONDENCE should be sent either through electronic case filing (ECF), or, for documents that cannot be filed on ECF, by email to [wtc\\_letters@nysd.uscourts.gov](mailto:wtc_letters@nysd.uscourts.gov). Any hard copies of documents sent to chambers will be rejected for failure to comply with this rule, except for courtesy copies delivered in accordance with Judge Hellerstein's Individual Rule 2(C).
- All correspondence in all other tracks of the 9/11 litigation remains the same.



## Subscribing To An RSS Feed Using Either Apple Safari or Apple Mail


By the term *subscribe* we mean that your computer will automatically reload the RSS-format web page at periodic intervals in search of newly published information.

Safari provides two methods for making a subscription (see red highlight in prior photo):

- “Subscribe in Mail” – Makes news articles appear in your Apple Mail program’s “Inbox” as new, unread messages,




- “Add Bookmark” – Makes news articles appear in Safari’s “Bookmarks” menu or on the Bookmark Bar.




With both programs you have the option via their respective “Preferences” settings to select the frequency with which they will automatically return to the web site in search of new information, as well as the manner in which the articles are presented.

Preferences for RSS viewing with Safari:



Henceforth, every time that you launch Safari or Mail these programs will update any RSS subscriptions that you may have made with them, and they will continue to seek out new information at the periodic interval you have set for as long as the programs remain running on your Mac.
